Many of the soldiers in the Army of Tennessee had enlistments that would expire in the spring of 1864, but their units passed resolutions while in winter camps at Dalton, Georgia, to reenlist for the duration of the conflict. Bohannon will examine these resolutions and provide an important window into the reasons why Confederate soldiers continued fighting after two years of war. The talk is adapted from an essay by Keith that appears in the book "Inside the Confederate Nation" edited by John Inscoe and Lesley Gordon and published by Louisiana State University Press in 2007.
