## The Great Revivals in the Confederate Armies

During the Civil War, a remarkable spiritual awakening, in a number of ways similar to the Great Awakening that swept America in the 1740s, took place throughout the Confederacy, in the armies, the hospitals and prisoner of war camps at Fort Delaware, Johnson's Island and elsewhere. The preaching of the gospel of Christ by chaplains, Christian officers, evangelists, local pastors, colporteurs, and men in the ranks exceeded anything previously experienced in military history except, perhaps, the armies of Cromwell in England or the Covenanters in Scotland.

Bill Potter, a resident of Cumming, Georgia, currently work as the chief historian for Landmark Events, a history tour company, headquartered in Tennessee. He leads tours in the United States and Europe, specializing in military history. Mr. Potter has acquired many documents and books related to this topic, and has lectured multiple times on this and related subjects at universities, churches, roundtables and SCV camps. He has published short books on Stonewall Jackson and G.A. Henty.
